

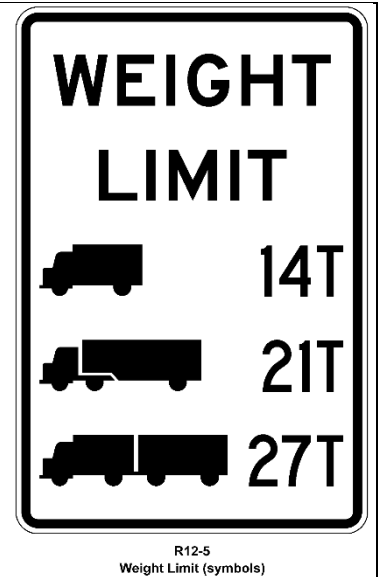
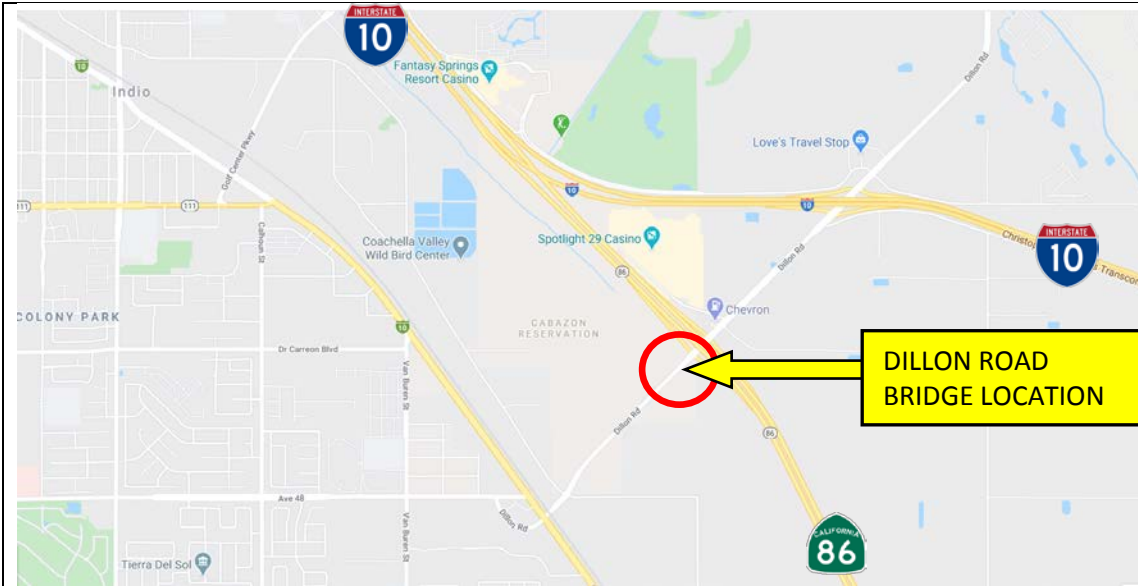

Notice of Public Hearing on Weight Limits Restriction on Dillon Road Bridge over Coachella Valley Stormwater Channel (CVSC) [aka Whitewater River]



WHY THIS NOTICE?

Caltrans Structure Maintenance and Investigations (SMI) Unit has performed numerous bridge inspections and load rating analysis on the Dillon Road Bridge. The results of the inspections and analysis required posting weight limits restriction signs on Dillon Road Bridge, to inform truckers to use alternate routes per California Vehicle Codes, Article 5. Bridges and other Structures [35750 - 35755]. They were installed on Jan 7, 2020. Two public hearings are being held to explain the new weight limits restriction and inform road users of alternative routes to use, as necessary. Also, to provide an opportunity to ask questions regarding the posted (R12-5) regulatory and warning [W-20 (CA)] signs.
