

### 25 HISTORIC COACHELLA FIRE STATION

 Coachella's first fire station is now home to the Firehouse Restaurant Bar and Grill.

### 26 COACHELLA CITY HALL CAMPUS

- The City dedicated this site in the heart of downtown in 1947.

### 27 HISTORIC WATERING TROUGH

 Located near the Hometown Heroes monument, this trough supplied water for horse teams bringing crops to town.

### **28** OLD CHURCH ON FIRST STREET

 Dedicated in 1924, this location was the first site of Our Lady of Soledad Catholic Church.

 This historic building has consistently housed migrant farmer assistance since the 60s.

### 30 HOMETOWN HEROES MONUMENT

 This monument is dedicated to Coachella's citizens making a difference.
